SPIPLEX Recreational Tournament Rules and Regulations

1. Teams will play with 7 players on the field including a goalkeeper.
2. All games are 30 minutes in duration. There is no half-time.
3. Only turf shoes, indoor flats or running shoes are permitted.
4. The three line pass violation is not in effect.
5. The ball will be kicked in, not thrown in. A goal cannot be scored on a kick in (including a corner kick).
6. If the ball makes contact with the ceiling, play will be stopped and an indirect free kick will be awarded to the team that did not have possession of the ball when it was kicked.
7. Substitution of players with the exception of the goalkeeper may be made at any time during the game provided the substitute does not enter the field of play until the player being replaced is within 1 metre of the bench area. The substitution of the goalkeeper must be done during a stoppage in play.
8. Teams may carry a maximum of 16 players.
9. Team roster, including full name of player **MUST** be submitted prior to the first game. It **cannot** change during the tournament.
10. If a player receives a red card or dismissal in a game she will be disciplined by tournament chair.
11. If the final is tied at the end of regulation time the game will go directly to Kicks from the Penalty Mark. (5 Kicks will be taken. Shooters do not have to be on the floor when the game ended. In the event of a tie after the first 5 shots by both teams, each team will continue with new shooters until a winner is determined. No player may shoot twice until all players and the goalkeeper have shot once. However, if there are uneven number of players, players may shoot a second time once all players of the team with the lesser numbers have shot. The final result at the end of regulation will stand in other placement games.
12. Tie Breaker in Group Play
 - 1) Head to Head
 - 2) Goal Difference
 - 3) Most Goals
 - 4) Goal Average
 - 5) Kicks from Penalty Mark (5 kicks, more if needed in case of tie)
13. Wild Card Playoff spots will be decided by Tie Breaking procedures in group play Rule 12 when teams play the same number of games in round robin. If groups are uneven and teams play a different number of games, then the Wild Card will be determined by the best goal average of the teams in second place in each group.
14. If a team has been disqualified all games will be null and void.
15. Failure to appear for a game will result in a 1-0 loss. Remaining games will be played as scheduled.
16. For any issues not covered in the above, a decision will be made by the Tournament convener. All decisions will be final.
